Joshua M. Hoffman – OSM Stream Protection Rule

OSM published a draft Stream Protection Rule that amends or modifies 475 existing rules within the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 (SMCRA). The STREAM Act has three objectives:

- Increase transparency in OSM's rulemaking process by requiring the publication of the scientific products, as well as the underlying raw data.
- Clarify OSM's jurisdictional and statutory authority under the SMCRA.
- Require the OSM, with the Interstate Mining Compact Commission, to conduct a comprehensive study through the National Academy of Sciences on the regulatory effectiveness of the 1983 regulation.

The state of the energy and mining workforce in the United States will be discussed as well as potential solutions to assure a trained and skilled workforce of sufficient size for the future.
