Director, Office of External Relations U.S. International Trade Commission The ITC's Work on Trade Safeguards

Abstract: Mr. Leahy has been the Director of the Commission's Office of External Relations since its creation in April 1996. He has had thirty years of experience in the field of international trade beginning in 1974 when he first joined the Commission's staff as an international trade analyst. He served as a senior investigator in the Commission's Office of Investigations from 1977 to 1984 before joining the staff of then Chairwoman Paula Stern as her Executive Assistant.

In 1988, Mr. Leahy joined the staff of the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative, Executive Office of the President as Deputy Director for Policy Coordination. In that capacity he served as Vice Chairman of the interagency Trade Policy Staff Committee and as Deputy Executive Secretary to the Trade Policy Review Group. He returned to the Commission in 1992 as Deputy Director of the Office of Executive and International Liaison and in 1996 served as Director of that office until it was merged into the Office of External Relations. He served as Director of External Relations until his retirement from Federal service on January 2, 2004.

Mr. Leahy was born in 1947 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He is a graduate of La Salle University in Philadelphia, receiving a bachelor's degree in economics in 1969. He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1970 to 1974. He is married with four children and nine grandchildren, and currently resides in Virginia.
